### Orthopedic Surgery

- Cranial cruciate ligament injury repair with tibial tuberosity advancement (TTA), Ruby bone anchor technique, or extra capsular suture
- Patellar luxation correction
- Femoral head and neck ostectomy
- Hip luxation repair (toggle pinning)
- Joint fusion (arthrodesis)
- Fracture repair
- Amputation (limb, digit, tail)
- Ulnar ostectomy for elbow joint incongruence

### Soft Tissue Surgery

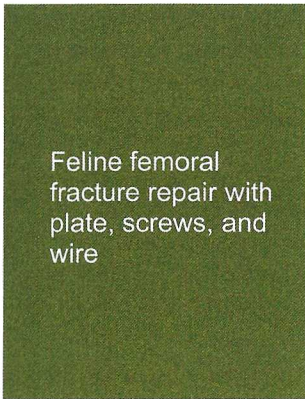
- Prophylactic gastropexy

## How Does it Work?

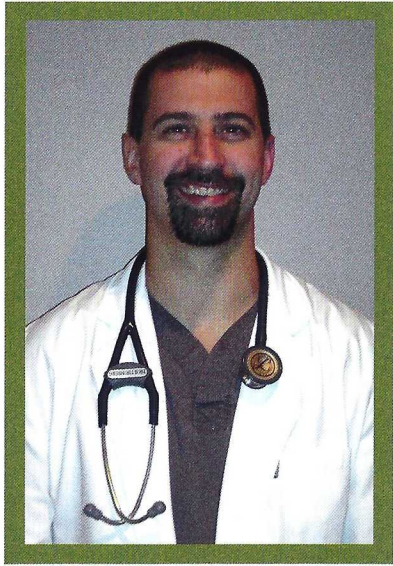


Once your regular veterinarian has examined your pet, and a determination is made for a consultation, they will contact Dr. Thunberg to set up an appointment. In some cases, the consultation and surgery may be able to take place the same day.

At the time of consultation, Dr. Thunberg will examine your pet and give his recommendations regarding surgery (*please be sure to bring your pet with you to the consultation*). Dr. Thunberg will fully explain the procedure to be performed to ensure that you have a clear understanding of what to expect on both the day of surgery and during the recovery process.

Dr. Thunberg will work closely with your regular veterinarian to ensure a seamless transition between surgery and recovery. Your regular veterinarian will then take over your pet's post-operative care.

While most follow up visits will be completed by your regular veterinarian, Dr. Thunberg will remain available to your veterinarian for any questions or concerns during the entire recovery period.

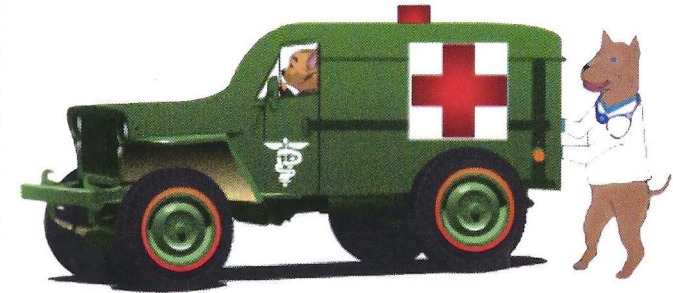
